Maggie Mae's 32 Anniversary Week-end Celebration will kick-off with a Golf Tournament at Grey Rock Golf Course, located at Circle C Ranch. Nestled in the Texas Hill Country, this championship golf course designed by renowned architect Jay Morrish is challenging, yet appealing for players of all skill levels. Grey Rock has served as the host course for the U.S. Open qualifier, the Buy.com/Nike qualifier, and the Texas Women's Amateur Championship. Grey Rock Golf Club has been named as one of the top 20 public golf courses in Texas by Texas Golfer Magazine and is recognized in Golf Digest's Best Places to Play.

The tournament will begin with a 1 p.m. shotgun start. Golf carts with coolers will cruise the course to supply complimentary beverages (beer sponsor) during the tournament. Before the tournament begins, lunch will be served with beverages and a band will play for entertainment in the Grey Rock Beer Garden.
